VOTER INFORMATION

Election Dates for 2017

April 17 Last day to register before Primary Election
May 9 Last day to apply for civilian absentee ballot
May16 Primary Election Day
Note: only registered members of a political party may vote in that party's primary. All registered voters may vote on referendum questions.

Oct. 10 Last day to register before November election
Oct. 31 Last day to apply for civilian absentee ballot
Nov. 7 General Election Day

To qualify to vote in Washington County, you must:

1. Be a US citizen at least 30 days prior to Election Day.
2. Be at least 18 years old by Election Day.
3. Be a resident of your election district at least 30 days immediately preceding election. Qualified voters who move from one district to another within the state during the 30 days prior to an election may vote in the district from which they moved.
4. Be registered to vote in Washington County.
5. Show ID if you are voting in a precinct for the first time.

Voter Registration

Register at the Dept. of Elections, County Office Building, Courthouse Square, Mon. through Fri., 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Online registration is available at Votspa.com. Mail-in forms are available at many libraries, government agencies, and from Votspa.com. Voters must submit any changes to name, address or party affiliation on the proper form on or before the last day to register to vote.

Absentee Voting

An absentee ballot may be used by a registered voter who expects to be absent from his or her municipality on Election Day; who is ill or incapacitated, who is an election worker, or whose religious holiday falls on Election Day. Application for an absentee ballot must be made to the Dept. of Elections not sooner than 50 days before the election, nor later than 5 p.m. on the Tuesday before the election. Official application forms may be obtained by mail, phone, online or in person. If an emergency arises after the deadline, an emergency application may be made until 5 p.m. on Friday before the election, or through Election Day with Court approval. Completed absentee ballots must be received by the Dept. of Elections by 5 p.m. on Friday before the election, or through Election Day with Court approval.

Be an effective voter

1. Know the candidates at election time. The Voters Guide, published before elections by the LWV, lists candidate information supplied by the candidates.
2. Let public officials know how you feel about issues.
3. Be active in the party of your choice.
